## COMMUNION AND CARE FOR THE HOMEBOUND

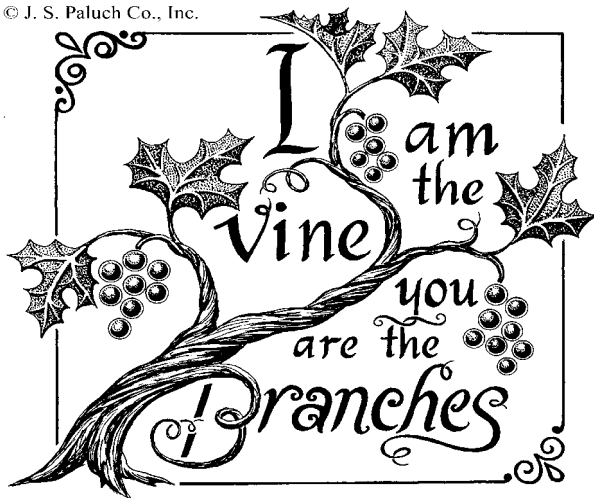

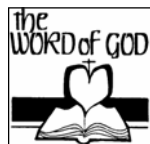

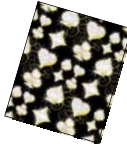
